Your right to elect to receive documents electronically or physically

The Corporations Amendment (Meetings and Documents) Act 2022 (**Amendment Act**) includes a new requirement for public companies and listed companies to give shareholders notice of their right to elect to be sent documents electronically or physically by the company in section 110K of the Corporations Act.

There are new options for how Allegra Orthopaedics Limited shareholders receive communications. Allegra Orthopaedics Limited will no longer send physical meeting documents unless a shareholder requests a copy to be mailed.

Providing your email address to receive shareholder communications electronically

Allegra Orthopaedics Limited encourages all shareholders to provide an email address so we can provide investor communications electronically when they become available online, which includes items such as meeting documents and annual reports.
